Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Just a brief note to thank you once again for your continuing support of our profession. As always it is an honor and pleasure to share some time with you in our quest to move corrections forward. I was overwhelmed by your support and look forward to years of working together in addressing our universal issues.

At the Superbowl gathering I offered to provide \$5 per month to the cancer charity for every ACOA member who joins ACOIN. This is an opportunity to generate a steady stream of revenue for not only this cause but for others you may see fit in the future. Every 100 ACOA members who join ACOIN will generate \$6,000 per year to the fund. It is my intention to donate to the cancer fund all of those proceeds for the first year as I offered at the Superbowl. After that the funds will be sent to whatever cause, fund or charity the ACOA chooses. If only 300 members from ACOA join ACOIN we will be sending you approximately \$1,500 a month or \$18,000 annually. That is a sizeable amount for the ACOA to put to good use for its members in need.

In addition all ACOIN members who join at the \$15.00 a month level receive the \$110,000.00 AD&D Benefit, and the \$25,000 hospitalization benefit that cover you 24/7 365 days a year as well as the \$2,200 benefit for your college age children in the event something should happen to you. Of that \$15.00, \$9.00 is tax deductible. For those choosing the \$20 a month family plan (\$11.00 is tax deductible) their spouses or significant others will be covered at \$55,000 per year and their dependent children at \$11,000. (If you have no dependent children your spouses benefit increases to \$66,000 per year. If you are a single parent your children's benefit increases to \$11,500 per year.) And of course all members get our monthly "Roll Call" update, our newsletter LOCKDOWN, our Urgent Alerts and access to the members only section of our websites, as well as discounts at Bally's Fitness, Avis, and CDT self-defense training programs.

This is a great opportunity for all ACOA members to support the profession nationally, while they protect their families, help us in our continuing fight against privatization AND support the cancer fund and future benevolent funds you may choose.

Thank you once again for all your support. I look forward to working with you and maybe doing some salmon fishing one of these summers! Be safe.
