

Acknowledgement of Authenticity

Everyone who applies for a remedy is required to sign an Acknowledgement of Authenticity.

This document is necessary to protect all of our members from potential liability. Arbitrator Gaunt's decision states that the settlement is only for those Officers who were assigned to the newly created forty-two (42) hour security shifts and the remedy was calculated based on only those Officers. Your signature below is to ensure that only individuals that worked the forty-two (42) hour security shifts participate in the remedy.

By signing the acknowledgement below, I understand that I am applying for compensation for the periods of time I was assigned to and worked on the newly created forty-two (42) hour security shift and understand that by signing and submitting this Settlement Request Packet, I am certifying that all the information and documentation I provide is true and accurate. I understand my failure to provide complete, accurate, and truthful information in this submission could result in my claim being denied or modified. I also understand that the monetary terms of the settlement are intended only for those who were assigned to forty-two (42) hour security shifts. Officers assigned to administrative positions are not eligible to receive a remedy. Examples of administrative positions include, but are not limited to: Housing Unit Supervisors, Institutional Training Officers, Institutional Compliance Officers, Disciplinary Sergeants, Records Sergeants, Special Projects Officers, Commissary Officers, Property Officers, Standards Sergeants, Security Sergeants, Job Services Officers, etc. No forty-two (42) hour administrative positions, including non-security light-duty positions, or eighty-four (84) hour positions are eligible to receive this remedy.
